

Recovery payment; One-time payment of \$250

President Barrack Obama signed into law the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act on February 17. The law provides for a one-time payment of \$250 to people who get Social Security or SSI.

Recipients' of Social Security or SSI are eligible for the \$250 one-time payment if they received benefits at anytime during

November 2008, December 2008 or January 2009.

To receive the payment you don't need to do anything. Checks will be sent to your bank or mailing address depending on how you already receive Social Security or SSI.

If you do not get a check by June 4, 2009 contact your Social Security office.
